Message from Gregg!

It is springtime. It's time for a garden. Sowing, cultivating, and growing! Spiritually, Jesus reminds us that we are called to be gardeners. Remember this parable from Luke 8:5-8, 11:

"A Sower went out to sow his seed. And as he sowed, some fell along the path and was trampled underfoot, and the birds of the air devoured it. And some fell on the rock, and as it grew up, it withered away, because it had no moisture. And some fell among thorns, and the thorns grew up with it and choked it. And some fell into good soil and grew and yielded a hundredfold. Now the parable is this: The seed is the word of God."

We are reminded of the garden God has given us, the work we are tasked to do, and where our gardening leads in the first verse of Robert Frost's poem, "God's Garden."

"God made a beauteous garden with lovely flowers strewn, but one straight, narrow pathway that was not overgrown. And to this beauteous garden He brought mankind to live, and said "To you, my children these lovely flowers I give. Prune ye my vines and fig trees, with care my flowers tend, but keep the pathway open, your home is at the end."

Jesus tells us that the seed we are to sow is the "word of God" and Christ is that Word. Metaphorically, the lovely flowers of "God's Garden" are us and those around us and our pathway the sowing, care, and the pruning that leads to God and to HIs bountiful harvest.

Robert Louis Stevenson said the greater thing to do is not "judge each day by the harvest you reap but by the seeds that you plant."

The outreach, service, and ministry of Lawrence Chapel United Methodist Church is sowing a tremendous amount of Christ's love and grace into the world and into our community. You are creating such

opportunity for a wonderful harvest in God's Garden and I am so grateful for all that you give, all that you do, and especially all that you are.
