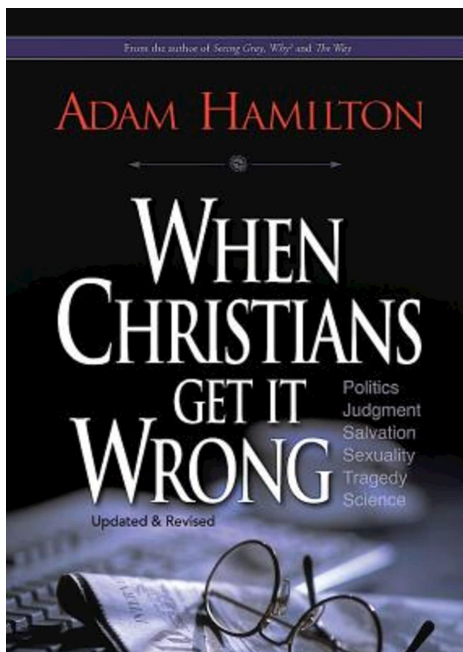

your faith during the season of Lent.**

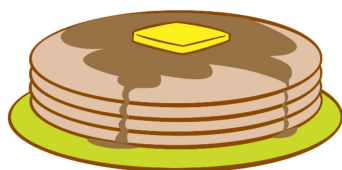

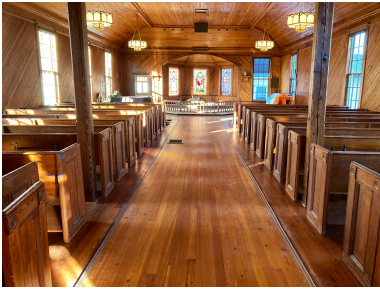

Behind the Scenes at Lawrence Chapel

We will begin a series on the duties and responsibilities for various committees in the Methodist Church. We hope this information is helpful to our members and others who are interested in Lawrence Chapel. This month we start with a description of Lawrence Chapel's Administrative Council which provides the administration for the church.

Our Administrative Council assists with planning and implementing a program of nurture, outreach, witness, and resources. Duties include developing a vision, with a plan to meet and implement our vision --

Lawrence Chapel Practices the Love and Teachings of Jesus .

Each year we evaluate the mission and ministry of the church. These consist of the nurture, outreach and witness ministries.

- The nurturing ministries of the congregation include education, worship, Christian formation, membership care, small groups, and stewardship for individuals and families of all ages.
- The outreach ministries focus on local and larger community ministries of compassion, justice, and advocacy. These ministries include church and global ministries, higher education and campus ministry, health and welfare, Christian unity and inter-religious concerns, religion and race, and the status and role of women.
- The witness ministries develop and strengthen evangelistic efforts by sharing personal and congregational stories of Christian experience, faith, and service; communications; Lay Servant Ministries; and other means that give expressions of witness for Jesus Christ.

Other Responsibilities for Administrative Council include:

- functioning as the administrative agency of the charge conference
- reviewing our membership
- filling interim vacancies occurring among the lay officers of the church
- establishing the budget recommended by the finance committee to ensure adequate financial needs of the church
- recommending to the charge conference the salary and other remuneration of the pastor(s) and staff members based on recommendations from the SPPRC (staff-parish, pastor relations committee)
- reviewing the recommendation of the committee on pastor-parish relations regarding provision of adequate housing for the pastor(s), and report the same to the charge conference for approval.
- leadership development and attention to the ongoing preparation and development of lay and clergy leaders for the ministry of the church.

- Through World Day of Prayer, women affirm that prayer and action are inseparable and have immeasurable influence in the world.
